KNOW THE POSITIONS



ENTRY-LEVEL COMMITMENT - STF COUNCILLOR



RESPONSIBILITIES

- *A local and provincial representative of the STF & RPSTA*
- *Helps out at Assembly*
- *Sits on at least one or two RPSTA committees*
- *Attends Fall and Spring STF Council in Saskatoon to represent members*

EXPERIENCE

No experience is required -

Communication and organization skills are an asset, and STF trains at conferences

TIME COMMITMENT

- *Attends Assembly (monthly)*
- *~5 evening meetings / year*
- *~3 days away from classroom / year*

TOTAL COMPENSATION

RPSTA & STF compensate councillors for work at council and provides reimbursement for mileage, meals and hotels.

Total ~\$1000/year.

MID-COMMITMENT - EXECUTIVE COUNCILLOR



RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs all duties of STF Councillor & leads Assembly groups
- Attends 2x monthly “Executive Meetings”
- 2+ Committees - chairs 1+ (organizes meetings, plans events, advocates, etc)
- Responsible for general oversight of the regular operations of the RPSTA (reviews expenses, provides feedback)

EXPERIENCE

No experience is required - STF/RPSTA knowledge, and non-profit board, finance experience is useful. Leadership, communication and management skills are an asset.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Average of **1 or 2 after school meetings per week**
- Regular communication with Executive outside of meetings
- Regular “duties” on committees

TOTAL COMPENSATION

RPSTA compensates Executive Councillors 4% of the max of class VI on the salary grid, in addition to STF Councillor compensation.

Total ~\$5000/year

HIGH-COMMITMENT - RPSTA VICE-PRESIDENT



RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supports all Executive and STF Councillors in performing their duties
- Assists in running exec meetings, organizes & supports 5-8+ committees (often LINC)
- Supports day-to-day operations of RPSTA (bargaining, events, comms, more)
- Represents RPSTA member voice to STF & RPSD senior admin, Principals & VPs, etc.
- MOU for 50% release - Admin functions, member support, operational support

EXPERIENCE

No experience is required - Significant STF/RPSTA & education sector knowledge, non-profit & policy governance skills, financial management experience are useful. Leadership, communication organization skills are an asset.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Average of **3-4 after school meetings per week**
- “Professional duties” equivalent to a .5 Teaching contract or greater
- ~4-6 visits to STF Head Office/yr

TOTAL COMPENSATION

RPSTA compensates Executive Councillors 5% of the max of class VI on the salary grid, in addition to councillor compensation.

Total ~\$6500/year

HIGH-COMMITMENT - RPSTA PRESIDENT



RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for all VP, Executive and STF Councillors in all duties
- Plans & runs exec meetings, organizes & supports all committees
- Executes or oversees all day-to-day operations of RPSTA, including STF & local bargaining, events, communications, member outreach, more
- Represents RPSTA member voice to STF & RPSD senior admin, media, more
- 100% release - Admin functions, member support, financials, etc.

EXPERIENCE

No experience is required - Significant STF/RPSTA & education sector knowledge, non-profit & policy governance skills, financial management experience are useful. Leadership, communication organization skills are an asset.

TIME COMMITMENT

- On-call - RPSTA cellphone 24/7
- **4+ after school meetings per week**
- “Professional duties” equivalent to a 1.0 Teaching contract or greater
- 6+ visits to STF Head Office/yr

TOTAL COMPENSATION

8% of the max of class VI on the salary grid & 10% stipend or pre-existing allowances, in addition to councillor compensation.

Total: ~\$19000-20000/year

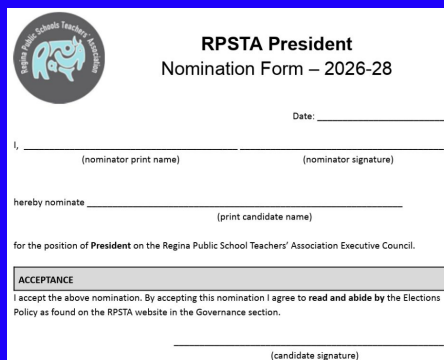
