

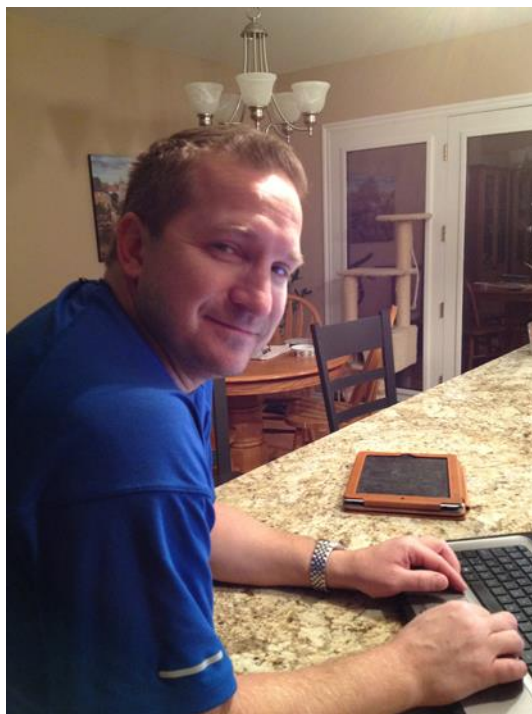
RE-ELECT BARRY HOULDEN TO THE RPSTA EXECUTIVE
